The Indiana Fraternal Order of Police will award up to ten (10) \$250.00 Scholarships per District (Northwest, Northeast, Central, Southwest, and Southeast) annually at the State Conference.

All applicants must be an immediate relative (son, daughter, stepson or stepdaughter) of an active or retired FOP member.

All applications will be judged by the applicable criteria, regardless of sex, race or religion.

A committee appointed by the State Board will select the recipients of the scholarship.

Each applicant must submit the following for consideration in order to be eligible for the scholarship drawing:

1. A completed scholarship application form.
2. Transcripts indicating GPA of 3.0 or 4.0 scale.
3. A copy of SAT or PSAT scores.
4. A minimum of 12 semester credit hours is required to receive this scholarship.
5. 250 word type written essay indicating scholastic accomplishments, extracurricular involvement and career plans.

All applications must be postmarked by March 1, 2018.
